Campground Rules & Information

Union Thresheree - Last Full Weekend in July

Fees: \$75 for the weekend Site size – 20' wide x 40' long *Show admission <u>NOT</u> included*


Registration: Campground opens Wednesday at **4:00 p.m.** - Campers MUST check in at the West end of the field – follow signs.

- 1. Camper registration hours are 7 a.m.-9 p.m. beginning at 4 p.m. Wednesday of the show week. Gate admission can be purchased in the Welcome Barn starting Thursday of the show.
- 2. Anyone camping before or after those hours will need to park in the parking lot and wait for registration to open the following morning.
- 3. No early parking of campers without approval or assistance of camping personnel. People doing so may be asked to move or may be removed from the showgrounds.
- 4. Registered campers must have a registration sticker in the camper window, visible to the road.
- 5. Security personnel will be on duty at night and will be assisted by the Waupaca County Sheriff's Department if necessary.

Campground Rules:

- 1. No black or graywater may be discharged on the grounds at any time. This is strictly prohibited per DHHS Regulations.
- 2. Quiet hours are **11:00 p.m.-6:00 a.m.** No loud noises, music, barking dogs, or generators.
- No motorized vehicles are to be used within Campground during quiet hours this includes but is not limited to: Tractors, Garden Tractors, ATVs/UTVs, etc. Show Officials, Law Enforcement/Security, and Emergency Personnel are EXEMPT from this rule.
- 4. Campfires are allowed UNLESS DNR burning ban is in effect. The camper MUST provide a fire ring and MUST pick up after! Fires MUST be kept under control!
- 5. Dogs/Pets are allowed on a leash, and under control. Owners, please pick up after your pets.
- 6. No sales are allowed in the campground. If you brought items to sell, you must set up in the Flea Market.
- 7. Parking of extra vehicles is allowed, only if they fit in your site. Mirror tags will be provided to campers to display in their vehicle that will stay on their site. No parking is allowed in driving lanes. If you wish to park your vehicle away from your site, you may park in the trailer parking area.
- 8. Please pick up after yourselves. Dumpsters are located on the South-East corner of the campground.
- 9. No bands or DJs are permitted in the campground without permission from the UTC Board of Directors, where a permit will be given to the campsite asking.
- 10. Camping is an outdoor experience. Therefore, we do not give refunds due to the discomfort of nature. The FUN continues rain or shine!
